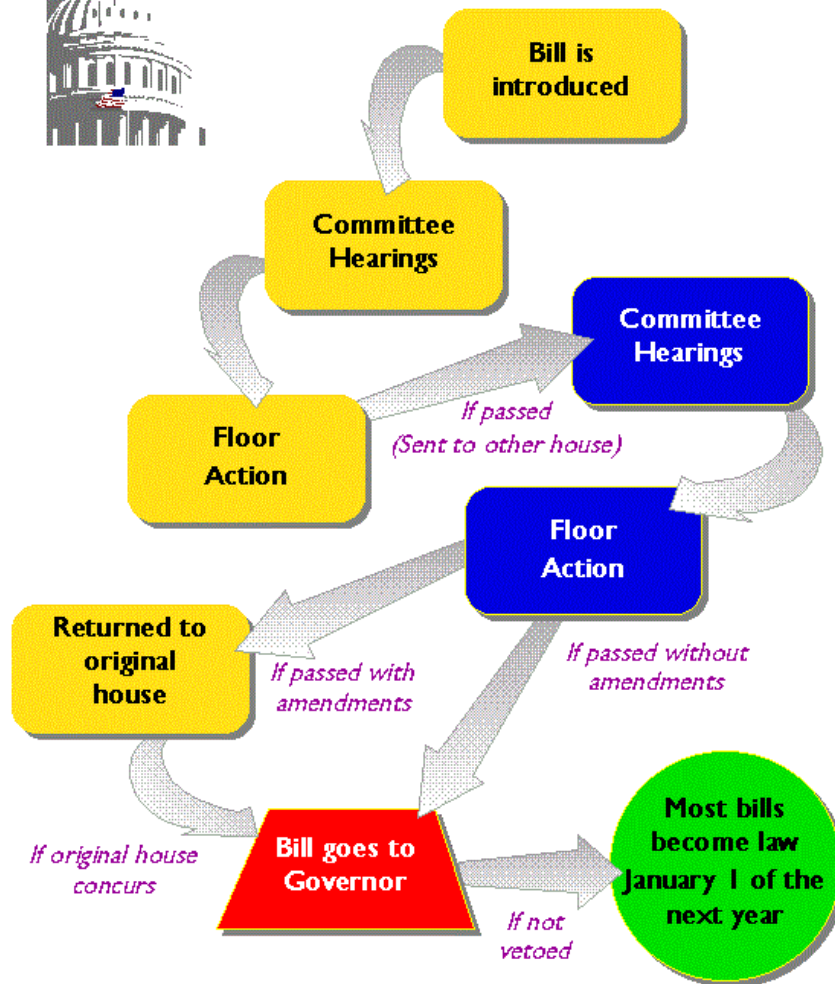

## When Should I Advocate?

Most public involvement, including speaking and letter-writing, happens during committee hearings.

People who want to testify on a bill - that is, say why it is good or bad - get to do that at those hearings.

Sometimes, advocacy teams will also write letters to the Governor, asking him to sign a bill into law.
